Phonics Screening Check

Each year, Year 1 undertake a screening check. Children will read 20 real words and 20 "alien" words, decoding using their phonics knowledge.

This will take place during the week of 9th June 2025.



Phonics Parents meeting


Next month, I will be hosting a phonics parents meeting to go through level 4 and 5 phonics and strategies which you could use at home to support your child.


