Maths	Pupils build upon the firm foundations made and embed and develop their calculation strategies. They calculate with fractions and decimals. Pupils identify factors, multiples and square numbers. In addition, they learn long multiplication. Through regular practice they become fluent and confident arithmetic experts. Maths lessons provide children with opportunities to develop their logical and critical thinking skills whilst answering reasoning questions across a range of topics such as: geometry, measure, simple ration and statistics. Pupils will be supported to develop their problem-solving skills whilst searching for patterns and relationships and when solving open investigations.





PARENT GOVERNOR


