




People Who Help Us



Books we will be sharing:





In Maths we will be learning all about:

- Counting
- Numbers 1-6
- Measures
- 3D Shapes and their properties.

By the end of this topic, Nursery children will be able to:

- Talk about people who help others in our families and local community.
- Act in role, applying their knowledge of job role responsibilities and key vocabulary.
- Understand what are healthy choices about food, drink, being active and toothbrushing.
- Ask and answer simple questions including why questions, speaking in a full sentence (4-6 words+)

Key vocabulary:

Help, kind, caring, dentist, teeth, vet, pet, doctor, nurse, health, police officer, safe, fire fighters, fire, school, teacher, headteacher, manager, office, mechanic, park warden, bus driver, train driver, taxi driver, clean, wash, germs, healthy, exercise, tooth brush, tooth paste, brush, twice, clean, dirty.

How you can support learning at home:

Talk to your child about who helps in the family and in the local community. Question them about the roles people take and why.
