

KEY KNOWLEDGE

Florence Nightingale was born in Florence, Italy on 12th May 1820

She trained as a nurse in Germany

Florence Nightingale worked as a nurse during the Crimean War

Florence Nightingale improved the conditions of hospitals

Florence Nightingale got the nickname 'The Lady with the Lamp' because she worked through the night

Many doctors didn't respect her because she was a woman

Florence Nightingale met Queen Victoria and was awarded the Royal Red Cross

Florence Nightingale died in 1910

Hospitals during the Crimean War were very dirty and unhygienic

Hospitals today are clean, hygienic and well looked after
