What is Phonics?

- Phonics is where children learn all the different sounds (phonemes) that letters of the alphabet make.
- They learn to hear, say, read and write all phonemes.
- This develops children's ability to read and write with increasing independence and confidence.
- As a school we use Floppy's Phonics does anyone remember him from your school days?




How we teach Phonics

In Reception Children follow this teaching sequence:

- Review This is where we recap the sounds we know.
- Teach This is where a new sound is taught.
- Practise This is where we use the new taught sound to spell and read.
- Apply This is where the children use the sound to write words/sentences.
- Consolidate This is where we recap the weeks learning to ensure children are developing a secure knowledge of Phonics.

How you can help at home

- It is really important that you don't encourage children to say the names of the letters (ABC) this will not support their ability to read and write.
- Reading weekly with your child and using the Floppy's book to consolidate that weeks teaching.
- Using oxfordowls.co.uk to access lots of free books and extra practice.
- Access some useful websites that have interactive games.


How you can help at home

- Each week, your child will come home with the 2 phonemes they have learnt.
- This is for you to look through with your child.
- Ask them to talk about the pictures.
- What sounds/phonemes can they hear?
- Can they have a go at writing the grapheme?
- You can keep it at home or bring it back to school. If you keep them at home, you will be able to refer to them over and over again.

How can Phonics be successful?

- School and home working together.
- Sharing learning on Tapestry.
- Home reading.
- Talking through the home learning sheets that are sent home these can be returned to school or kept at home. You could maybe upload a photo/video to Tapestry to show their progress.
