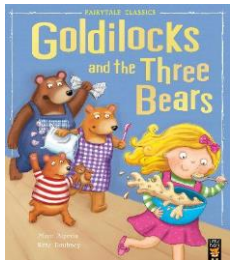
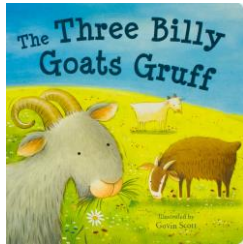


# Once upon a time
