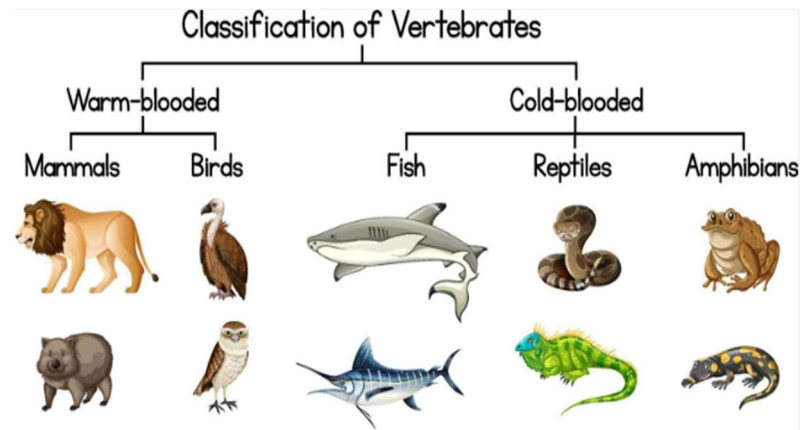

Children should be able to identify and name a variety of animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.

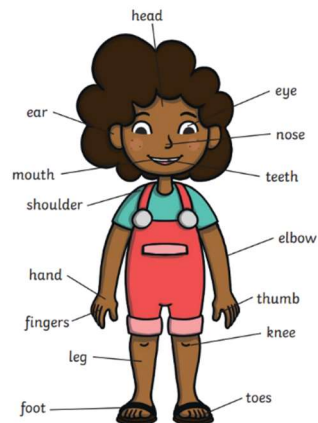
That animals can be classified into carnivores, omnivores and herbivores.
