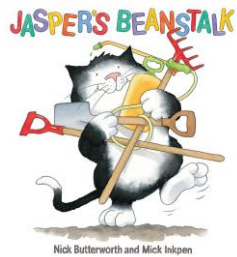
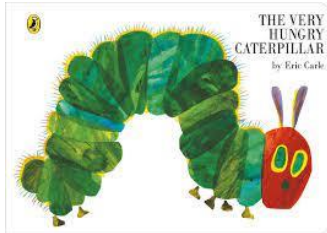


In the Garden

In Maths we will be learning all about:
